


Directions for the *Do it Yourself Ring-Tape*

1. Cut out the 25 pieces along the dotted lines.
2. Make mountain folds along the dashed lines.

3. Take one of the *unit forms* and glue ends together to form a square in profile.
4. Do the same for the 23 other *unit forms*.
5. Take the *soon-to-be ring band* and place glue on area Z and attach to the unprinted side of the other glue area to create a square in profile. Place glue on the other glue area and attach to the plain end of the soon-to-be ring band.

6. Organize the unit pieces alphabetically, and begin to glue panel A to panel A and B to B, and so on keeping the same patterns on the same side. You should flatten the square temporarily while gluing. When done there will be five larger units.
7. Keeping the pieces flat, glue the two pieces with  together. Do the same for the other patterns. Put glue only on the panels marked with the patterns. Let dry.
8. Unflatten the now almost complete

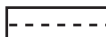


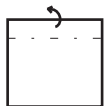
- ring. Place glue on the area indicated on the *soon-to-be ring band* and roll this band upon itself to form a ring that fits the desired finger. Continue to roll the ring until it hits the main piece- you may to put more glue on the band so that it attaches to the two squares. Crease the band where it hits the outside edges of the two squares so that the band forms a D shape.

9. When dry, place ring on finger and flatten and expand ring to make desired shape. Adorn Yourself
