Who Do You Think I Am?!

May 2–August 8, 2021

Grounded in the intersection of physical, emotional, and cultural experiences of the queer female body, Flavia D'Urso's multichannel video installation *Who Do You Think I Am?! (2017)* is a visceral meditation on disorientation and desire.

Within D'Urso's immersive, womb-like space, abstraction and abjection converge to create an experience that is both destabilizing and seductive. Ghostly, illegible, images and sounds—both human and animal—co-exist and meld in an intersectional space intended to feel leaky and alive, alluring yet grotesque.

Flavia D'Urso is a Sicilian-American artist working in sculpture, video, and mixed media. D'Urso earned an MFA from California College of the Arts in San Francisco and a BA from Skidmore College in Saratoga Springs, New York. Her work has been exhibited at Grand Central Arts Center, Santa Ana, California; San Diego Art Institute; Hermes Artes Visuais, São Paulo, Brazil; Root Division, San Francisco; and NOVA Art Space, Weimar, Germany. She lives and works in San Diego.
