

MARY NOHL AND THE WALRUS CLUB

WORDS TO KNOW

Materials: Materials are the things you need to make something. Mary used art materials, like color pencils, to make art. She also used materials that she found, like tree trunks, to make art.

Routine: A routine is something you do regularly, often in the same order. You might have a routine when you wake up, for example, getting dressed, eating breakfast, and going to school.

Inspired: When you get a new idea from a person or from something you see, hear, or read.

Mary Nohl (1914–2001) was an artist from Wisconsin. She made art every day out of many different kinds of **materials**. Making art was an important part of her **routine**. Some of her artwork is displayed in this exhibition.

Mary **inspired** many artists. There are eight other artists in this exhibition who created artwork **inspired** by Mary Nohl.

Anne Kingsbury is an artist who is inspired by Mary Nohl. You can see her art in *Mary Nohl and the Walrus Club*. Just as Nohl did, Kingsbury uses a journal to write and draw about her routines.
